
## **ACTIVITIES**

Autism-friendly cinema screenings are sometimes called relaxed or sensory-friendly screenings. Adjustments are made to reduce stress and sensory input, such as low lighting and sound, freedom to move and staff trained in autism awareness.

- <u>Cineworld Sheffield</u> has an autism-friendly screening on the first Sunday of each month at 11am.
- The Odeon has an autism-friendly screening around the third Sunday of the month, and is currently trialling autism-friendly screenings for older audiences once a month.
- The Showroom Cinema has its Kids Inclusive Cinema, KIC Start, on the third Sunday of the month at 1pm.
- <u>Vue Meadowhall</u> hold their autism-friendly performances on the last Sunday of every month at 10am.
- Barbie You Can Be Anything: The Experience -SEND Sessions at Meadowhall have reduced sound and music levels and are limited to a maximum of 20 people in the space.
