Ways to Help your Child at Home

<u>Reading</u> – The expectation is that all children should read at home four times a week. Reading books will not be changed until we have seen that it is recorded in their learning log that they have read it at least 3 times. Any other books that have been read at home can also be recorded in their learning log. Reading is a fundamental skill for children and we want to help foster a love of reading within them both at home and school.

<u>Spelling -</u> We do not have formal spelling tests in class, but we learn spelling patterns that we then revisit and reinforce through our writing. There are lists of tricky words, zero tolerance words and common exception words in the front of your child's learning log, which it would be really helpful if they were practiced at home.

<u>Maths</u> - Children are encouraged to access TT Rockstars or Numbots at least twice a week to practice their number facts and multiplication and division facts. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ also has lots of fun maths games, one that is really beneficial is 'hit the button', which focuses on recall of key number facts.
